## YOUR HOME, YOUR OFFICE

### *Office furniture for the home from TEAM 7*

In recent years, working from home has evolved from a marginal phenomenon to a familiar and popular way of working. Initially just a temporary solution during the coronavirus pandemic, it is now firmly established in many industries. This cultural shift also poses new challenges for the design of our own four walls. TEAM 7 helps to harmonise living and working with flexible natural wood furniture.

People work in the office and relax at home: this well-established rule no longer applies. In many places, digitization and flexible working hours have created new realities. More and more people are working from home permanently or at least partially, which means that working from home has become an integral part of our everyday lives. This raises a fundamental question: How can we design spaces so that both focused work and cosy living are possible in them? The answer is flexible, multifunctional room concepts. With well thought-out designs, an enormous range of products and numerous planning options, TEAM 7 opens up new perspectives for working at home.

#### Option 1: the complete office

There are several approaches to designing a home office space. If there is plenty of space, a complete workspace can be set up. The centrepiece is usually a spacious desk, such as **pisa** by Kai Stania. Made from pure natural wood, it combines all the requirements of a modern workplace with comfort and cosiness. The angled lifting column is both a design element and an innovative technical feature: it enables infinitely variable electric height adjustment that can be adapted to individual requirements with millimetre precision. Anyone who has had enough of sitting can therefore also use the desk while standing.

Additional storage space for files and documents is provided by the matching **pisa** desk pedestal or a customised **cubus** shelf, which can also serve as a visual partition to the living room. The office space is completed by a suitable, back-friendly seating option: for example, the **girado** swivel chair, which has a sculptural appearance with its three-dimensionally moulded wooden backrest and also fits perfectly with the **pisa** desk.

## Option 2: the integrated office

If you don't want an office atmosphere to detract from your home feeling, you can also elegantly conceal your home office. This requires intelligently designed furniture that only reveals itself when in use and then recedes stylishly into the background once the work is done. The **filigno** secretary desk is a perfect example of this: at first glance a tasteful piece of



wooden furniture in a minimalist mid-century style, the design by Sebastian Desch proves to be a sophisticated multifunctional tool. An extendable desk top offers sufficient work surface and leg space, as well as access to a highly functional interior. If required, a screen can also be extended via a lift, which is attached to an integrated, height-adjustable monitor holder. Additional functions such as USB ports, a power socket and an optional Qi charging station make the **filigno** secretary desk a fully equipped home office workstation.

The **sol** secretary desk is also a real all-rounder: whether free-standing or supported by two legs, it can be used as a desk, dressing table or storage surface. Two interlocking shells - one made of wood, the other covered in leather - form the smart basic idea. The table top from **sol** can be pulled out and allows comfortable sitting. Utensil boxes, milled pen trays and other features make organisation easier. With its clear proportions and gentle curves, **sol** is also a real eye-catcher.



## Option 3: multifunctional areas

If there is no space available for an office area or if there is a conscious decision not to free up living space for it, planning skills are required. Thanks to its unique vertical integration, TEAM 7 has unique expertise in this area: Furniture can be customised down to the last detail according to personal specifications, be it individual rooms or entire interiors. Consistent, flowing designs with different types of wood can be realised across all living areas, from the dimensions to the interior layout. For example, a small office can be accommodated in a customised built-in wardrobe or the niche under the stairs - which disappears completely behind closed doors if required.

One of the core competences of the manufacturer from Upper Austria is making room furnishings usable in a wide variety of ways. This also applies to individual pieces of furniture that move effortlessly between living environments: Extendable dining tables such as **tak** or **mylon**, for example, which are used for doing schoolwork or organisational tasks. Or a chair like **lui légér**, which is so ergonomic and comfortable that it can be used both at the dining table and at the desk. In this way, TEAM 7 harmoniously combines living space and workplace - and thus stands for the next generation of working from home.
